



What our Charges Cover

We publish our fees list to ensure transparency around our charges. Our fees list shows our full fees before any government funding is applied and show sessions. A session is a morning or afternoon. A whole day is 2 sessions.

If you have indicated on your application form that you wish to access the Enhanced Provision, this will include:

- Consumables (e.g. spare nappies, wipes, sun cream, bibs etc..)
- A range of weekly activities including Performing Arts, Football Coaching, Yoga, Ballet, Fizzy Phonics, Whizzy Maths and Mindfulness*
- Various Celebrations

**Run by outside providers. Please note that not all outside providers are used every week or every term.*

Charges for Additional Hours

Our daily charge for sessions not covered by early years entitlements is £15 per hour when booked at the start of a term. This fee includes all the elements listed above under Enhanced Provision. If ad hoc sessions are booked at short notice during the term the charge is £20 per hour.

All charges will appear on your termly invoice. Please refer to our Terms and Conditions for further details.

Parent Declaration Form

Please note that before we can claim for any early year's entitlements, parents must complete and return the Hillingdon Parent Declaration Form that we will provide. Without this form, we will not be able to apply for funding.

Funding Age Bands

Please note that the funding parents receive decreases as the child gets older. The funding rate changes at age 2 and at age 3, in the term **after** the child's birthday. To summarise:

Funding Tier	Age	
Highest	9 months to 2 years	Available from age 9 months until the term after your child turns 2
Middle	2 years	Available from the term after your child turns 2 to the term after they turn 3
Lowest	3 & 4 years	Available from the term after your child turns 3 to when they leave.

Dates to determine ages in each term:

- Autumn – 1 September to 31st December
- Spring – 1 January to March 31st
- Summer – 1st April to 31st August
